## WISCONSIN EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE

Emergency assistance is offered to low income families in Wisconsin. Priority is given to families with children and people who may be at most risk, such as seniors or the disabled. People who have received a foreclosure or eviction notice may qualify for housing assistance. Low income families in Wisconsin who have a disconnect notice for their utilities or if your heat or electricity is shut off you may be able to get aid. Programs can help people who currently live in a shelter or transitional housing find a new home, and pay for security deposits and rent when they move. Or, if you are just starting to fall behind on your mortgage, rent, or bills, help and guidance can be provided. To learn more or to apply for help, you need to apply at your local Wisconsin Works agency, or **dial 855-757-4539** for the nearest agency. There are conditions that need to be met. The total amount of financial assistance provided will be based on your family size and your personal situation.

## WISCONSIN (BADGER HEALTH) ASSISTANCE

A program for both children under 19 years of age and also for families in Wisconsin who want and need health insurance. This service can help with paying medical bills and expenses. BadgerCare Plus is a program for all kids, regardless of income.
